Wyalkatchem Local Government Area

According to the 2011 Census, the Wyalkatchem LGA has a total population of 525 people:

- 13.7% were born overseas
- approximately 4.0% were born in a non-main English speaking (NMES) country
- 2.1% speak a language other than English at home.

(Total - Not Stated = Fixed Figure).
